Mid-West Collegiate Championships Rules of Eligibility:

Students must meet the following Criteria:

1. A member in good standing with USA Judo, USJA, or USJF.
A copy of your current membership card will be required at registration.
2. Is at least fifteen (15) years of age as of the date of the tournament. Proof of age consisting of birth certificate, passport, or current USA Judo membership card having the age verification symbol "V" printed following the date of birth. **Note: A Driver's License is not acceptable as proof of age.**
3. Is currently enrolled as a full-time Student in an accredited college or university. The student must carry no less than 12 semester hours or 12 quarter hours.
