AGE CUT OFF

Masters – Must be 30 years of age as of date of tournament or older

Seniors - Must be 13 years of age as of date of tournament or older

Juniors – Must be younger than 17 years of age as of midnight, as of date of tournament

RULES: Current International Judo Federation Rules as modified:

1. Junior Division – 8 through 16 years of age
 - a. Juvenile A (age 13 through 16)
 - i. No Kansetsu waza allowed - Shime waza is allowed
 - b. Juvenile B (8 through 12)
 - i. No Kansetsu waza allowed, No Shime waza allowed
2. Senior Division – (age 13 and above)
 - a. Kansetsu waza is allowed regardless of competitor's age
 - b. (Minimum age to enter senior division is 13 years.)
3. Pre 2003 medical rule will be used for Jr. Division's only
4. Blue belts must be worn by the blue competitor and a white belt must be worn by the white competitor.

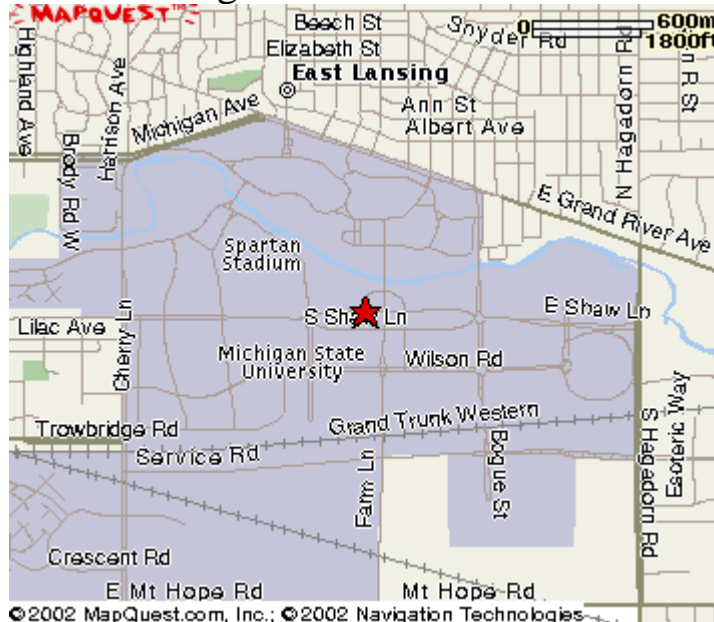

Coming from the North.

Going South on US 127 to East Lansing exit. I believe it Howard St. Stay on Howard St. drive till Kalamazoo St. It's the last St before you get back on US-127 or I-496. You will turn left on Kalamazoo St. The next light will be Harrison Rd. Keep going straight on Kalamazoo St. After you cross Harrison rd. you are now be on campus. Go past the first turn to the right that's to Bresling Center. Go about 100 yards or so turn right in between Dem Hall and the Munn ice arena. The bldg that is straight in front on you is the IM West bldg. There is parking on the side and in front of the bldg.

Coming from the West.

Get on I-496 go to East Lansing / North 127 exit 8. Stay to the left for East Lansing and at bottom of hill turn right onto Kalamazoo St. The next light will be Harrison Rd. Keep going straight on Kalamazoo St. After you cross Harrison rd. you are now be on campus. Go past the first turn to the right that's to Bresling Center. Go about 100 yards or so turn right in between Dem Hall and the Munn ice arena. The bldg that is straight in front on you is the IM West bldg. There is parking on the side and in front of the bldg.

Coming from the East and South.

I-96 to 496 / US 127 North - Follow signs to Clare exit 8 than get off first Exit 76 Kalamazoo St. At bottom of hill turn right onto Kalamazoo St. The next light will be Harrison Rd.
